This workshop will focus on useful approaches, processes and ideas for bringing and keeping groups and teams together, having conversations that really matter – and having FUN.

This workshop will help you:

- Create cohesive groups
- Polish your role as a facilitator
- Explore approaches that build common agendas
- Gather a variety of participation techniques for your tool kit
- Deal with difficult behaviours and conflict
- Develop the ability to move flexibly and adapt with what emerges

Leading in Communities

Community-led development practice challenges our ways of thinking, acting and leading. It tests our assumptions about leadership – who has it, how we grow it, how we connect the diverse voices. It nurtures and develops emerging local leaders. This workshop explores frameworks and tools for thinking, acting and leading amidst complexity, where leadership is primarily about continuous learning on the job.

This workshop will help you:

- Recognise your leadership strengths as an active citizen in your community
- Identify strategies for fostering leadership of others, across diverse groups and sectors
- Explore tools and strategies to make sense of challenging leadership situations
- Apply frameworks that help you discern how, where and if you might intervene in complex situations
