9.45am	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pecha kucha from: • <i>SOUL Ihumātao</i> – mana whenua led movement to save “one of the few significant and unique historical, cultural, spiritual, social and environmental spaces we have left in Auckland”. • <i>WISE</i> – refugee women-led catering service to “use their skills, get to know others, grow in confidence and generate income”. • <i>Glen Eden Pataka Kai</i> – street pantries offering resident led, grassroots, crowd sourced solutions to immediate and local need, rescuing food and encouraging the co-sharing between neighbours to strengthen communities. • <i>Rainbow Youth Community Wardrobe</i> – Rainbow young people led free, identity affirming clothing for people to experiment with, try new things, or get clothing in times of need and give back, by donating clothing. • <i>We are Beneficiaries</i> – Artist-led visual conversations sharing hundreds of experiences of life as beneficiaries and demanding a more compassionate welfare system. These stories were collated into a themed report for the new government.
