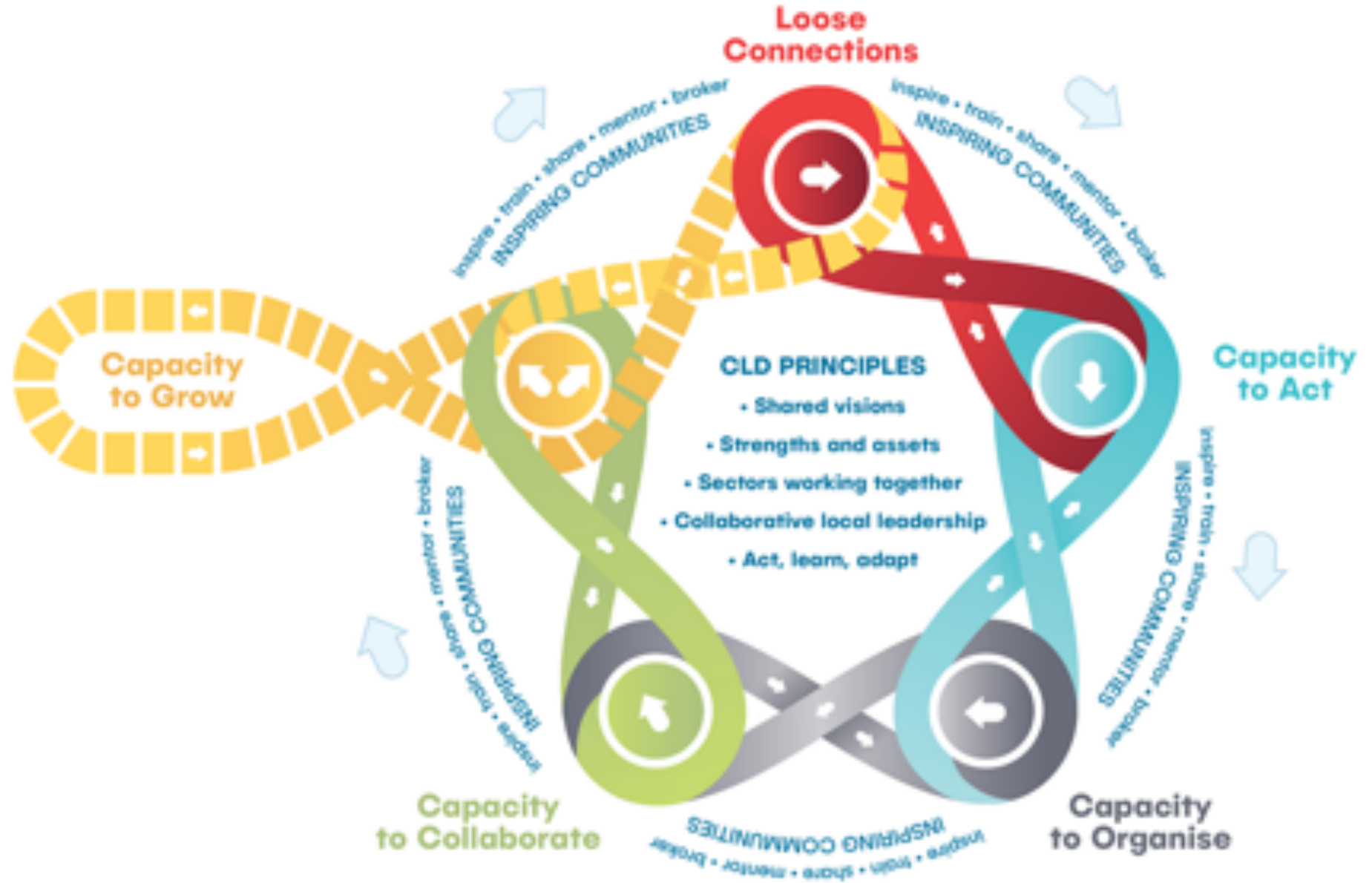

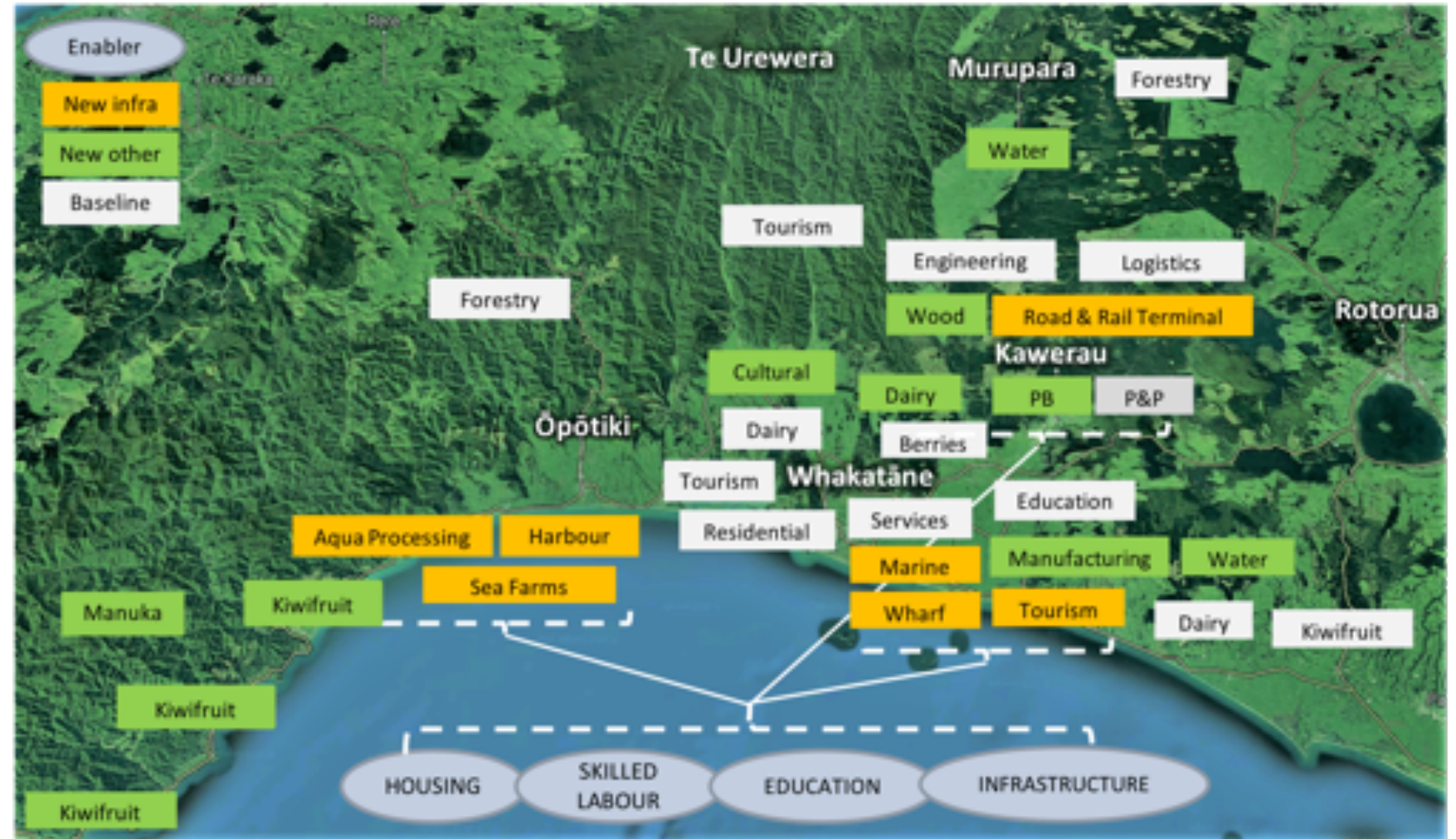

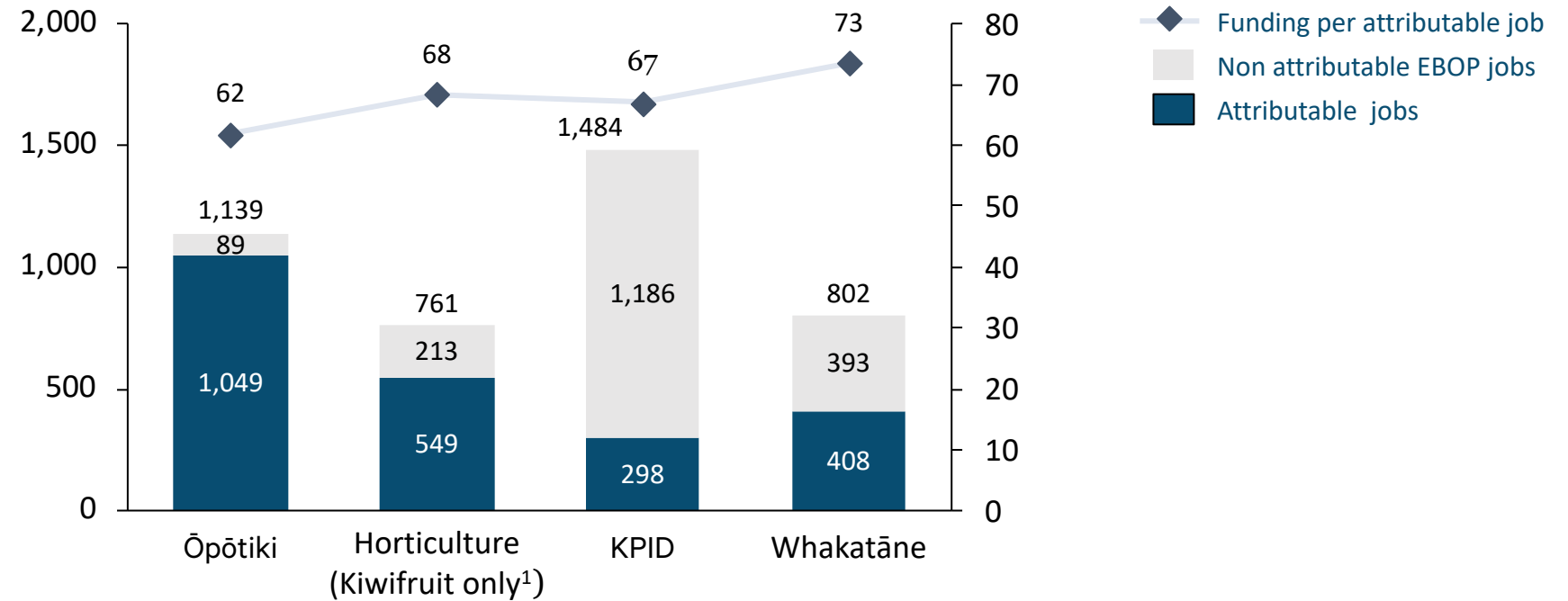
Over 65 projects in developing sectors indicated massive opportunity.
